The admission to the class of film and stage design consists of 2 steps, both are required:

- 1.) Portfolio and personal interview
- 2.) Three-day admission test

1st Step  
Portfolio and personal interview

24. February – 25. February 2020 from 10 am – 1 pm

It is necessary to deposit your portfolio with your work samples. In this occasion, the applicants have the possibility of a short, individual conversation with the teaching staff.

A specific interest in generating space, as well as a desire for theatrical implementation of it, your previous works and your experience are important for your application.

Upon successfully passing the first step you will be invited to the admission test.

**Information on Portfolio:**

- any medium (analogue/ digital)
- works (drawings, paintings, fotos, images, videos, models etc.)
- CV including an updated foto of the applicant
- drafts and sketches of spaces, showing the way you deal with different areas such as theatre, plays, operas, literature, music, dance, film, ...
- drawings, models, fotos, research, process
- work samples reflecting your inspiration resource, your personal interests and ideas on space, staging and aesthetics

2nd Step  
Admission Test

26. February – 28. February 2020

It is necessary to work in the classrooms. The test includes different requirements in written and practical form, dealing with theatre, film, visual arts, music, literature, architecture etc.

Announcements and handing out of the portfolios will take place in the week of 2. - 6. March 2020.
